We ask that visitors do not use their own barbecues, permanent stands are provided (see map) and note that disposable barbecues are prohibited. Please leave them tidy and guard against risk of fire. We also provide bookable barbecues for large groups.

Test your map reading skills and fitness level on our 20 Orienteering course. Maps can be purchased from the Forest Office during opening hours, the Tourist Information Centre in Wendover or from the 'Café in the Woods'. There are a range of suggestions for the beginner through to the more experienced.

Orienteering

Barbecue stands are provided, see map for location, on a first come first served basis. We also have bookable barbecue stands for larger groups. These come with picnic tables and are set within individual woodland glades. Contact the Forest Office to book.



Barbecues

Set amongst the trees, this is the perfect place for children to have fun. Please note that dogs are not permitted in this area.

Children's Play Area

There is a network of well signed permissive bridlepaths throughout the wood. These can be used with a permit which is available from the Forest Office.

Horse Riding Trails

This trail is hilly in places, and is suitable for those with a good level of fitness. Follow the green and white bicycle waymarkers.

Family Cycle Trail

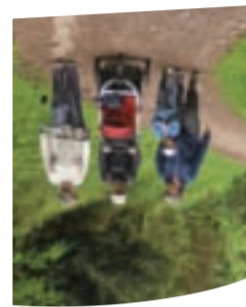


This trail starts from the bookable BBQ car park and follows a log-edged path. It is suitable for all.

All Ability Hilltop Trail

Constructed by volunteers and training staff from nearby RAF Halton, this is a testing trail around the edges of the banks of the Iron Age Boddington Hill fort. It is suitable for those with a moderate level of fitness. Information boards can be found at each of the exercise points.

Forest Fitness Trail



This trail is suitable for confident walkers. It is named after the firecrest, Europe's smallest bird, which is only 9cm long and weighs only as much as a 10p coin.

Forest Trails & Activities

Welcome to Wendover Woods

Situated on the northern edge of the Chiltern escarpment Wendover Woods affords spectacular views across the Vale of Aylesbury. You are welcome to explore all of the 325 hectares of mixed coniferous and broadleaved woodland.

If you fancy an energetic day, why not try the large permanent orienteering course, designed to test the best, or the gruelling Fitness Trail? The Family Cycle Trail is an ideal way to explore the woods on wheels or why not 'Go Ape' on the tree top adventure course.

Alternatively, walk the Firecrest Trail which leads you through the many habitats within Wendover Woods. If this sounds too energetic then take a leisurely stroll along the All Ability Hilltop Trail and stand at the highest point of the Chilterns, followed by a drink at the 'Café in the Woods'.

Signposted from the B4009 between Wendover and Tring. The main entrance is 250 yards along the St Leonards Road on the right.
